Chronic Otitis Externa: This is a condition of the external ear canal caused by a chronic reaction to an irritant or allergen. Many believe it is caused by a reaction to molds or fungus. Itching is often a symptom, but severe pain may be present.

Diseases of the External Auditory (Outer Ear) Canal

The external auditory canal (EAC) is typically 24 mm in length with a volume of 1-2 mL. The lateral third of the canal is made of fibrocartilage, whereas the medial two thirds are osseous. During early childhood, the canal is straight, but takes on an "S" shape by the age of 9.

Outer Ear & Diseases Related To It The outer ear is the external portion of the ear, which consists of the pinna and external auditory meatus. It gathers sound energy and focuses it on the eardrum (tympanic membrane).

Impaired hearing is, with rare exception, the result of disease or abnormality of the outer, middle, or inner ear. Serious impairment of hearing at birth almost always results from a dysfunction of the auditory nerve and cannot be improved by medical or surgical treatment.

The mammalian ear is divided into external, middle, and inner ear components, which differ in their embryologic origin (Figure 47-4). The external ear consists of the pinna, the EAC, and the tympanic membrane, and is embryologically derived from the first and second branchial arches, and includes both ectodermal and mesodermal components.
